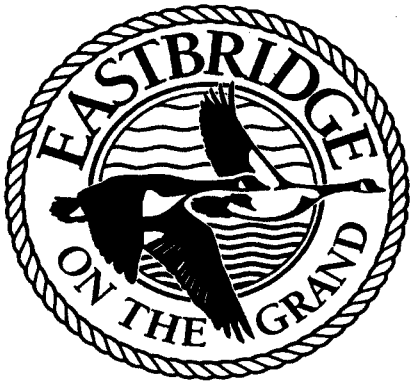

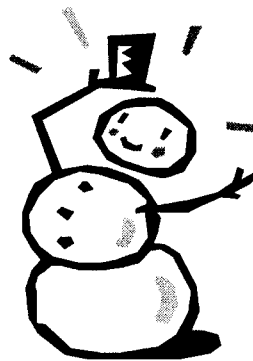
This will be our second annual contest. Let's get into the Christmas Spirit and decorate our homes! Judging will be done between December 17 and 22.

There is a Community Garden Program nearby. Christ Lutheran Church and the Waterloo Regional Food Bank sponsor it with support from the City of Waterloo Community Services. It is located at Christ Lutheran Church at the corner of Davenport, Anndale and Lexington. The garden is used by the church as well as by members of the community.

The purpose is to:

- do environmentally sound gardening
- make use of available land for those who might not otherwise have a garden
- develop a sense of community
- grow produce for service groups like House of Friendship
- provide educational and social activities (organic gardening and canning workshops)
- enjoy the fruits and vegetables of our labour

## General Meeting Overview

Thank you to all who came out and shared their ideas and concerns. We are on our way to developing a safer and friendlier neighbourhood. Based on the suggestions voiced at this meeting we are happy to confirm the following:

1. Gazebos will be lit up at night to deter vandalism.
2. Eastbridge park zone areas were assessed by a city official on October 21, 1999. We may see crosswalk lines painted on the road from parks to gazebos; we may see "Children at Play" signs on both sides of the street, facing both directions.
3. City officials are considering cutting the curb and opening the path at the gazebo for easy access from the pirate-ship park.

Additional concerns regarding vandalism, reckless behaviour, regular street patrols and illegal parking on streets were also voiced. Perhaps more solutions can be explored as we implement our Neighbourhood Watch Program.

Traffic and speeding issues were also discussed. Among the suggestions to slow down motorists' speed include stop/yield signs, speed bumps and islands. However, such changes will not occur without a stronger voice at the appropriate level. Thus, we strongly urge you to voice your concerns regarding this, or any other issue. Let us all make a difference.

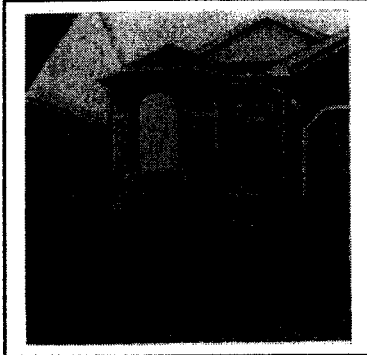
Thanks to all the people who came out to the events and enjoyed all the fun. As we start to grow things will only get better.
