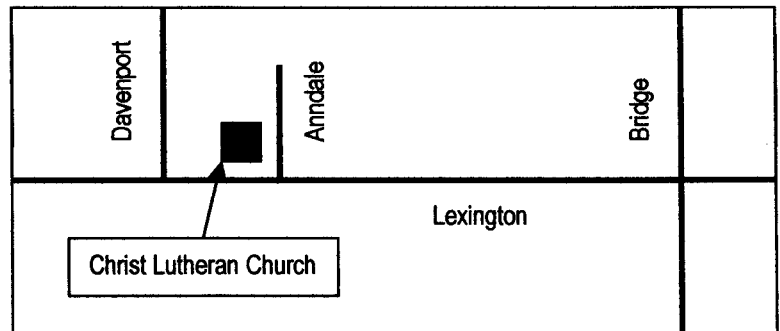
Community Garden Program

Communities in Bloom

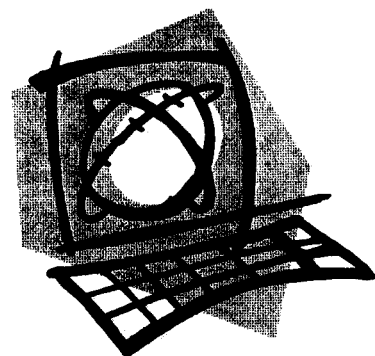

Our Community Is Going Online!



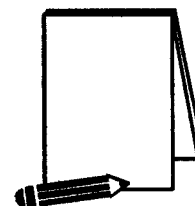

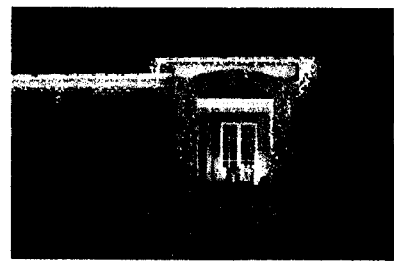

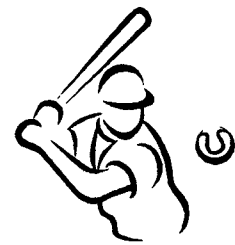
