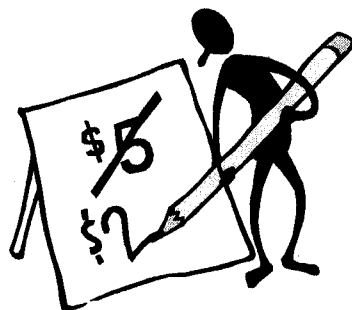
## Welcome 'Moorings of Eastbridge'

## A Note From Genstar

This year, Genstar plans to continue with the beautification of the Neighbourhood through its' ongoing landscaping efforts, including the installation of the decorative hanging baskets on the light poles on Eastbridge and New Bedford.

As the construction season is in full tilt, we wish to advise that if you are planning a fence or deck construction, please check with your "builder" or the city first as to any restrictions, and to ensure that your lot grading will not be adversely affected. In addition, if you are planning to install a pool, we wish to remind you that your Purchase and Sale Agreement contains restrictions which requires you to contact Genstar, so we can ensure that no damages occur to municipal services.

Now that University Avenue is open to the future RIM Park, Genstar will be continuing with another Stage of residential development in our Phase 2 lands, north of New Bedford. As we are all excited about the new schools in our community to be completed soon, Genstar is also hopeful that the commercial/townhouse site at the NE corner of Bridge and Eastbridge will finally proceed this fall. We also plan to service the small vacant single family parcel, south of the entrance gates on Bridge Street. We will continue to advise your Neighbourhood Association of upcoming Informal and Public meetings.
